Dear Margie,

This letter is to confirm that the below products comply with the American Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA HR 4040) requirements:

• INK-W, INK-P, INK-SK, INK-B/GL, INK-PG, BH Hardener, BH/GL Hardener

- Lead content of printing inks in children's products 90 ppm maximum,
- Phthalates limited to 0.1% in any children's toy that can be placed in a child's mouth or child care article:

diisononyl phthalate (DINP),
diisodecyl phthalate (DIDP),
di-n-octyl phthalate (DnOP)


- Phthalates prohibited in any children's toy or child care article that contains concentrations of more than 0.1% of these substances:

These products do not contain lead or the mentioned phthalates. These substances are not part of the formulations. According to the information from raw material suppliers these substances are not contained in the raw materials. These substances are not used during the manufacturing process.
